The Course

The Living as a Muslim in Today's World course has

been designed to develop students' knowledge and understanding of Islam in historical and contemporary contexts through a range of key topics and the teachings found in the Qur'an and Hadīth. It will enable students to develop their skills of analysis and interpretation in the context of questions and issues that affect Islam and the lives of Muslims today. And there'll be time to ask Abu Khadeejah questions related to contemporary issues related to Muslims living in the West.

This is a basic level course suitable for <u>male students</u> of age 9+ and especially those new to Islam, or new to practicing Islam. It may also serve as an excellent foundation for those who wish to take the iGCSE or A-Level Islamic Studies course in the future.

The course content has been created by **Shaikh Abu Khadeejah** '**Abdul-Wāhid** and includes 100+ lessons with new content being added weekly—and all praise is for Allāh, may Allāh bless it.

This 60-minute class will take place on the weekend (Saturdays) to benefit those busy at school, college, or work during the week. The time of the lesson has been set to suit as many time zones as possible, *inshā'-Allāh*.

The cost of each weekly class is £12.50. This includes homework for those who choose to do it (it is not mandatory). Two or more from the same immediate family are discounted at £10 for each family member. Payments are taken three months in advance, and places are limited to 25 students only. Any applications thereafter will be placed on a waiting list and will be offered a place as soon as one becomes available.

Course Duration

The course will be delivered as a 1-hour per week lesson, with holidays as arranged by Abu Khadeejah. This 1-hour class will take place on Saturdays 12pm to 1pm BST, UK time. The time of the lesson has been set to suit as many time zones as

possible. Lessons will begin on the first Saturday of July (1st July 2023), inshā'-Allāh.

- o The Prophet (صَلَّاللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) as leader
- o Battles fought by the Prophet (صَالِّاللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَوَسَالَةٍ)
- o The Prophet's (صَالِّلَتُهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالَّۃِ) final acts and his achievements
- Introduction to Islam
- o Allah, the One worthy of worship
- o The Risālah (Message)
- o Belief in the Messengers



- 1. Students will need a <u>Gmail</u> (Google email) account. Once you've set it up, please email <u>admin.sa@abukhadeejah.com</u> from the Gmail account with your full name.
- 2. Lesson Format: We will use "Google Meet" and "Google Classroom" to conduct the classes. Please take time to familiarise yourselves with both. Don't worry too much if you cannot grasp it immediately, we will help you along.
- 3. Assignments (if you choose to do them) will be submitted via Google Classroom.

- 4. Students will need to have regular access to a laptop or desktop computer for use in lessons and for submitting assignments. Students must be in a quiet space free from distractions
- 5. Students will be able to communicate with Abu Khadeejah and ask questions relevant to the class during and after the lesson (within an allotted time). Students will also have access to Abu Khadeejah via WhatsApp and a Telegram group for occasional questions and clarifications (inshā'-Allāh). Parents of students are welcome to access and view these conversations.
- 6. All lessons will be conducted in English, so Arabic is not a requirement.
- 7. The first 3-month payment should be made immediately upon applying. Subsequent payments should be made at least 7-days before each three-month session begins. You will be notified when the payment is due. Any delay in payment may result in denial of access to the classes. You will not be charged for holidays or tutor absences. If Abu Khadeejah is travelling or occupied, he will re-arrange the class day/time to one that is still over the weekend (Saturday/Sunday), inshā'-Allāh.
- 8. The fee is £150 (GBP) for three months per student (based on 4 hours per month), to be paid in advance. Please add the student's name as the reference and the code '9Plus' (e.g., Abdullah Harris 9Plus) alongside your payment—that allows us to track the source of all payments. You can save your payment receipts directly when you pay, so will not require a separate

receipt from us. We accept payments from all over the world. Note there are no refunds for student absences, but students can leave the course at any time—so if you decide to leave, it makes sense to leave at the end of three months to make the most of your paid course because there will be no refunds once payment is made.
